

## BOSS Mobile

Providing Fire Officers with real-time information for ongoing incidents

BOSS Mobile is a web-based application that is specifically designed for mobile devices. Utilising a mobile design framework, the BOSS Mobile client provides compatibility along with a consistent style across a variety of mobile platforms.

### Features

- ✔ Multi-platform application
- ✔ Search for incidents from the Vision database
- ✔ Quickly view assigned incidents
- ✔ Quickly view incidents in your area/zone
- ✔ Incident bookmarking allows user to bookmark an incident for quick viewing
- ✔ View informed incidents and send response (proceeding, not proceeding)
- ✔ View and update your current status
- ✔ View incident details and narrative, and show incident on map
- ✔ Add narrative to an incident
- ✔ User location visible on VisionDS in Control Room
- ✔ Encrypted user login system with back-end accounts database
- ✔ Mobile Administration tool for managing and creating accounts



## 1) BOSS Mobile System

Once connected to BOSS Mobile you are presented with the following options:

- Incidents
- My Status
- Tools
- Settings

Within the Settings option you can set your call-sign. Once this has been entered you will see any incidents within your area/zone/beat or those that have been assigned to you.



Within the Incidents option you can view:

- My List (Incidents you are assigned to)
- Starred (watched) Incidents
- Recent Incidents
- Search for Incidents (criteria can be entered)

Once you are connected to BOSS Mobile – the application will recommend that you add this page to your home screen for fast and easy access in the future.

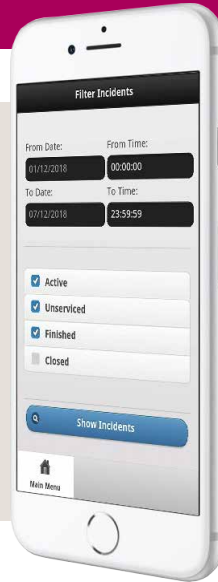


## 2) Search

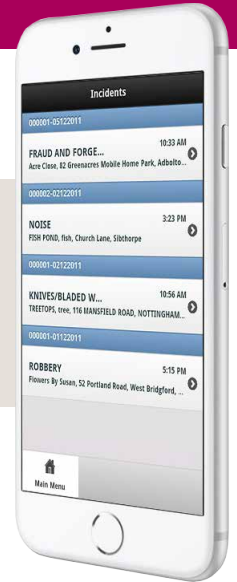


When searching for incidents, the option to filter is presented where date and time timelines can be applied. It also presents the option to show incidents that are:

- Active
- Unserved
- Finished
- Closed



Incidents are shown in a list format with Incident Number and time the incident was created.



## 3) Details

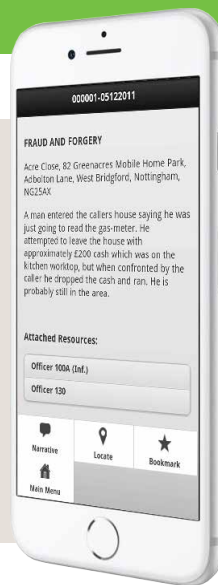


For each incident the following information can be viewed:

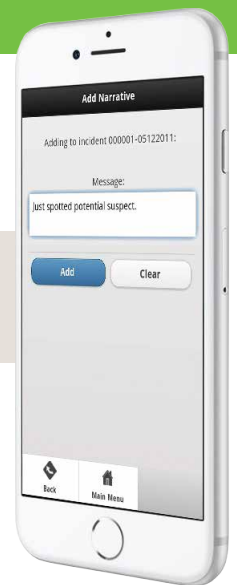
- Location Information

- Bookmark the Incident (Starred Incidents)



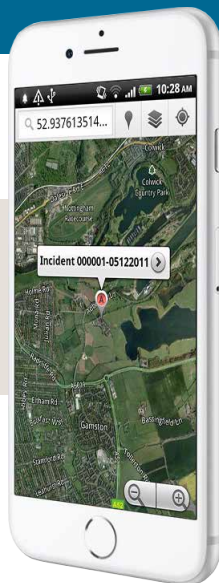
Adding narrative to an incident.



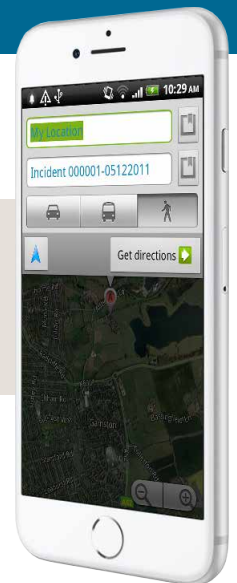
## 4) Location
